


There was once an owl called Dotty, A nurse with a uniform all spotty.




She works in the hospital up the hill, Looking after all the children who are ill.

That is why there is lots of things we are doing to help keep people well.




Schools have shut for a little bit so Dave is doing his work at home,

This is to make things as safe as can be even though it feels a little strange.




And where you can go to may change as well as who you can see,

Depending on where you live to keep things as safe as can be.




There may be times when you need to do a coronavirus test,

Children do not need to wear them and some people who are not able to too, But most adults wear them now because it helps protect each other when they do.




Nurse Dotty reminds Dave that washing his hands is still the most important thing, That Dave can do to help protect his family and him.
