(Min 10 Days) - Self-isolate the whole household                                 | they feel better. | my child tests negative   | - Contact school to inform us - Discuss when your child can come back (same/next day)  | the test comes back<br>negative and your child<br>feels well enough to<br>return   |  |
| my child is ill<br>with symptoms not<br>linked to COVID-19<br>(sickness and/or<br>diarrhoea). | - Do not come to school - Contact school to inform us - Ring on each day of illness  | after 48 hours following<br>the last bout of sickness or<br>diarrhoea. As per<br>attendance policy   |  |
| my child is ill with symptoms not linked to COVID-19 (runny nose and/or sore throat).         | - Check temperature and for symptoms of COVID-19 - If no COVID-19 symptoms, come to school if well enough - If not well enough, ring on each day of illness                          | they feel better and are<br>showing no symptoms of<br>COVID-19   |  |
| someone in my<br>household has<br>COVID-19<br>symptoms  | - Do not come to school - Contact school to inform us - Self-isolate the whole household - Household member to get a COVID-19 test - Inform school immediately about the test result | the test comes back negative   |  |

| my child's class<br>(bubble) is closed<br>due to a COVID-19<br>outbreak in school        | <ul> <li>- Do not come to school</li> <li>- Your child will need to isolate for 14 days</li> <li>- Siblings can continue to attend</li> <li>At home support your child with remote education.</li> </ul>  | school informs you that<br>the bubble will be<br>reopened.                     |
